## **WARNING**

Employees committing Workers' Compensation Fraud are subjected to severe penalties for submitting false injury claims.



## What is FRAUD?

According to the California Insurance Code, Section 1271.4(a), it is unlawful to do any of the following:

- » Make or cause to be made a knowingly false or fraudulent statement in support of a claim for compensation for the purpose of obtaining compensation
- » Knowingly assist, abet, conspire with, or solicit a person in an unlawful act
- » Make or cause to be made a knowingly false or fraudulent statement with regard to entitlement to benefits with the intent to discourage an injured worker from claiming benefits or pursuing a claim
- » Knowingly present or cause to be presented any false or fraudulent claim for the payment of a loss or injury (this includes any payment for lost time or modified duty pay)

## PUNISHMENT FOR COMMITTING WORKERS' COMP FRAUD

- » Imprisonment in County Jail for one year
- » Imprisonment in in the State Prison for 2-5years
- » Fined up to \$ 50,000 or double the value of the fraud, whichever is greater

A person convicted of workers' compensation fraud shall be ordered to pay restitution and be charged the costs of the investigation.
